David Harman has been Music Director of the RPYO since 1993. Dr. Harman received his Doctor of Musical Arts degree from the Eastman School of Music and has conducted widely throughout the United States and abroad. Professor of Music at the University of Rochester and Music Director of its Symphony and Chamber Orchestras, Dr. Harman also serves as Music Director of the Penfield Symphony Orchestra. Dr. Harman has been honored by the Monroe County School Music Association and by Mu Phi Epsilon, the international association of professional musicians, for his significant contributions to the musical life of our community.
